Dr. Krishnamurthy is a physician, public health specialist and a researcher, active in the space of public and global health for close to two decades. His focus has been on developing and scaling up innovations to address inequities, quality of care and quality of life, through application of program science, multi-disciplinary approaches and implementation research methods. His experience spans across the areas of HIV, Maternal, Neonatal and Child health (MNCH), Non communicable diseases (NCD) and Primary Health Care in the low and middle income countries.

Currently, as Professor and Dean at Faculty of Life and Allied Health Sciences, Ramaiah University of Applied Sciences, he supports masters and doctoral courses in Public Health, in addition to giving impetus to multi-disciplinary research. He is also on the senior advisory team of Karnataka Health Promotion Trust that implements large scale public health projects in India. His interests in advancing quality of life through integrative approaches led him to establish Center for Integrative Health and Wellbeing in Bangalore, India.

In the past, as Senior Technical Advisor, Centre for Global Public Health, University of Manitoba, Canada as well as India Health Action Trust, he led and supported public health projects in Indian and African settings. He holds a part-time faculty position with the University's department of Community Health Sciences. He is also the India site coordinator for International Infectious Disease and Global Health Training Program ([iidghttp.com](http://iidghttp.com)) that trains doctoral and post-doctoral students from India, Canada, Kenya and Columbia in multidisciplinary research.

He completed M.B.BS from Mysore and MD in Community Medicine from Bangalore; received training in research methods at W.H.O, Geneva and also holds a post-doctoral research fellowship from Canada.
